## **FLOOD RESPONSE IN ASSAM 2017**

With recurring floods in Assam affecting over 17 lakh people across 26 districts of the state, the Government of India and other relief agencies in Assam have been hard at work extending support. Lakhs of stranded people have been relocated to relief camps.

In order to reach out to severely affected communities, the Reliance Jio team in Assam has identified several areas which haven't received adequate relief support, and has started working towards assisting communities in those areas. Aiming to reach out to 2,500 families, the Reliance flood response team in Assam started delivering ready-to-eat food and ration kits on August 22, based on a situational analysis presented by the ground team. While this initial target has been achieved, the team is now planning more ways to maximise its reach and extend further assistance to affected communities in the state.
